Shettleston Harriers is a club steeped in history, starting back in 1904, a thriving, family friendly athletics club catering for all from competitive athletes to those who want to keep fit. With a membership of over 350 the club provides opportunities in various disciplines from Road Running to Cross Country and Track & Field. Arguably the most famous Harriers of all time were to follow in the 1970s and 80s with Lachie Stewart and Nat Muir. Lachie winning Gold in the 1970 Commonwealth games in Edinburgh and Nat dominating the Cross Country and road scene both in Scotland and the UK. The appeal of Shettleston Harriers is epitomised by the fact that although the club remains rooted in the East of Glasgow, membership is far and wide, not only in Scotland but now around the world.

Scottishathletics in partnership with Shettleston Harriers and Glasgow Sport wish to recruit a Coaching Pathways Development Officer to lead in raising coaching competency, focusing on developing coaches which will directly impact on athlete retention. The role will support the delivery of coach centred professional development (CPD) and education opportunities, including mentoring and parent/ athlete workshops, linking directly to **scottishathletics** and Glasgow Sport programmes.

You will engage and work alongside a number of key partners to develop clear coach and athlete pathway within Shettleston Harriers. You will be passionate about coach and athlete development and have experience in working with volunteers and managing projects.

With flexible working hours, including evening and weekends, this part time post (10 hours per week) is funded through a partnership between Glasgow Sport, Shettleston Harriers and **scottishathletics**. You will be an employee of **scottishathletics**, have annual leave entitlement and access to the group pension scheme.
