An exciting opportunity has arisen within North Ayrshire AC for a Club Together Officer – Community Coach in partnership with **scottishathletics**, North Ayrshire Council and KA Leisure. Club Together is a fundamental project within Scotland's National Club Development programme for Athletics, *Club Legacy 2014* that places a key focus on supporting the development of athletics clubs in the country.

The role will have a significant impact in the growth and development of club athletes, coaches and officials whilst developing the coaching infrastructure to allow the club to reach its goal of becoming one of the leader providers of athletics in the country. An overview of existing pathways into the club and the creation of further feeder/satellite groups to the club will also form part of the successive candidate's role. Ensuring the development of athletes and coaches through planning and delivery of education programmes will also be key to this role. Our vision of increasing participation and performance sit at the heart of everything we do.

The Community Coach will lead and mentor the coaching team, Local Authority coaches and Active Schools volunteer coaches where necessary and promote coach development through local courses, CPD and National Development Days.

A detailed job description, specifying clearly how the key Business case targets will be delivered, will be agreed with the successful applicant.

This part time post is funded through a partnership between North Ayrshire AC, **scottishathletics**, SportScotland, North Ayrshire Council and KA Leisure. Club Together is exactly that – clubs, **scottishathletics** and Local Authority coming together to deliver once and for all a programme that will make the athletics vision happen.
