- Educate scottishathletics performance athletes and support staff to protect them from inadvertent doping and to outline the procedures and consequences directed by WADA
- Promote scottishathletics as a clean sport with anti-doping embedded in our culture

- All 4J Studios National Athletics Academy athletes to complete I Run Clean online education course
- All 4J Studios National Athletics Academy to receive appropriate Clean Sport Education (March/ April)
- Athlete education to be tracked by scottishathletics so that there are up to date records of what each athlete has completed
- ❖ Track status of performance programme (inc. UKA) athlete education
- Commonwealth Games and Commonwealth Youth Games long list athletes to complete relevant Clean Sport education

### Coaches/ Staff

- scottishathletics Performance Team staff to complete UKAD Advisor course
- All team staff and coaches associated to performance programmes to complete the relevant Clean Sport education course
- 4J Studios National Athletics Academy Coaches and Staff to attend Clean Sport Education (same date as athletes)
- Check and challenge supplement use within the programme aligned with Assessing the Need, the Risk and the Consequences

# Parents/ Guardians

4J Studios National Athletics Academy Parents/ Guardians to be offered to attend Clean Sport Workshop (same date as athletes)

#### **TEST ADMINISTRATION**

Where relevant and appropriate, scottishathletics to offer a staff member to attend tests with any athletes

### **PROMOTION**

- @scotathletics to follow relevant accounts (@UKantidoping and @WADA) on social media and interact where relevant
- UKA Clean Athletics/ UKAD information on the scottishathletics website to signpost all members
- Identify appropriate scottishathletics and Scottish Schools Athletics Association events where outreach work can be delivered
- Privacy statement on the online event entry system outlining anti-doping responsibilities to entering athletes
- UKA Clean Athletics Awareness/ UKAD Coach Clean courses to be promoted to coaches in Scottish coaches and clubs
