Best- and worst-case scenarios have been considered and the paper outlines proposed steps that could be taken to reduce expenditure and to increase income over the next three years, including, but not limited to, but not limited to, consideration of changes to membership fees for Scottish Athletics and jog scotland , and new office accommodation.		
	JR highlighted that many of the proposed income increases impact the clubs, and many could be time consuming for clubs to implement.
