Selection Policy Overview

The selection of teams for scottishathletics Track & Field International Representative Matches will be made by a Selection Committee which will consist of a Chair, who is not an employee of scottishathletics and whose appointment is agreed by the Board, two representatives from the Performance Team, two representatives appointed by Track and Field Commission (of whom one must sit on the Commission) and the scottishathletics official historian. Voting rights will be held by Head of Performance (or substitute) and one representative from Track & Field Commission and the Chair will have the casting vote. Track and Field Commission will appoint a secretary for minute taking purposes.

Their selection will be made according to the following criteria:

- 1. The scottishathletics eligibility rules shall apply. All athletes must have completed the necessary Eligibility process in advance of the selection date.
- 2. Athletes must be current members of scottishathletics on date of selection meeting.
- 3. Where the selection for an event involves an athlete with whom a selector is closely involved e.g.as Personal Coach, then the selector involved will play no part in the selection for that event.
- 4. Only athletes who will benefit from the standard of competition at a particular event will be selected and the selection committee has discretion to leave places empty if necessary.
- 5. The decision of the selectors is final. Any correspondence regarding selections must be forwarded to the Chair of Selectors via scottishathletics for response. No other response will be deemed official.
- 6. All international selections are dependent on athlete full acceptance of the terms of the International Athlete Code of Conduct issued to all selected athletes.
- 7. See the selection notes for each international for additional detail specific to the fixture.
- 8. Any athlete substitutions resulting from changes in athlete availability, fitness status, injury, illness etc. occurring post-selection will be based on named reserves from the selection meeting. Any further substitutions that may be required beyond this are the responsibility of both the Performance Team and Selection Group.

Selectors will make their decisions based on nominations from the scottishathletics Performance Team, where appropriate, taking account of:

- The needs of the sport to continue to develop and retain athletes towards key senior outcomes.
- Current Scottish rankings and performances in nominated trial events (where appropriate).
- Current and, where applicable, head-to-head form.
- The nature and quality of the event at which performances were achieved e.g., presence of qualified officials, use of automatic timing/wind gauges, licensing status of facility etc.
- Consideration will be given to wind speeds in making athlete comparisons.
- Athlete availability.
- Any other relevant factors e.g., fitness status, ability to compete at the required level, commitment to and conduct at previous international opportunities.



Selection Committee & Procedure

Voting rights will be held by Head of Performance (or substitute) and one representative from Track & Field Commission and the Chair will have the casting vote.

The process of each selection is as follows:

- The selectors will call a meeting where the team will be selected. This will be on the designated selection date.
- Athletes will then be formally notified by email as soon as possible following the selections. A telephone call may also be made to speed up this process and allow travel confirmations to be made.
- A formal team announcement will then follow from the **scottish**athletics office, normally in the form of a press release and message on the website.
- Any questions related to selection should be addressed through the Chair by contacting the scottishathletics office.
- A condition of selection will be the requirement of athletes (or their parent/guardian/coach) to let the scottishathletics office know of their acceptance of selection – this must be within three days of receipt of the selection email or telephone call.
- Athletes will be contacted by selectors to agree their training and racing program up to the international and asked not to communicate selection in any way (e.g., on social media) prior to the formal team announcement.

International Programme Notes

Selectors have the discretion not to allocate all the places shown if it is considered that the event is not appropriate for the standard of athlete available.

It is essential that coaches and/or their athletes keep the selectors informed of their race programme and their desire to be considered for selection. This is best done by e-mail or telephone:

Anti-Doping

It is strongly recommended that all selected athletes undertake the '100% Me' UK Anti-Doping eLearning course.

To access the courses, you need to register on the UK Anti-Doping Clean Sport Hub. Your registration details will determine which course is appropriate. Athletes should select the 100% Me course. This course is currently free and can be accessed at Welcome to eNetLearn - eNetLearn (https://ukad.enetlearn.com/Login/?c=82).

There is a recommended requirement to complete this course every two years.
