About the Role

To deliver after school athletics activity in partnership with Active School and to create pathways into Inverclyde AC to help grow the membership. The role will develop further engagement with Branchton Community Centre and the provision of athletics to the local community.

Staff

scottishathletics employs 33 members of staff and 21 Club Together Officers.

Place of Work

Working between the club training base at Ravenscraig Stadium and within Primary Schools in Port Glasgow, Greenock East and Greenock Southwest and Branchton Community Centre.

Salary

The starting salary offered for the post will be £6,760. Annual pay awards will be made in accordance with the salary review procedures agreed by the **scottish**athletics Board of Directors.

Hours of work

The person appointed will be expected to work for 10 hours per-week. Due to the nature of the post, there will be a requirement to work in the evenings and at weekends. The organisation encourages a flexible working approach from all staff, consistent with meeting the needs of the business.

Pension

scottishathletics operates a qualifying group pension scheme for auto-enrolment purposes and will match the successful candidates' contribution up to a maximum of 6% of salary, including the legal minimum contributions required.

Annual Leave and Public Holidays

The annual leave entitlement for this post is 25 days pro rata. In addition, the public holiday entitlement is 10.5 days pro rata.

Travel and Subsistence

The post holder may occasionally be required to travel to meetings within Scotland and occasionally in the UK. Travel and subsistence will be reimbursed at **scottish**athletics' current rates.

Probationary Period

All new members of staff will serve a six-month probationary period before their appointment is confirmed.
